



City of Moreno Valley Economic Planning Department:

This letter is written in response to the proposed World Logistics Center project. It is apparent that the City Planning Commission and City Council have chosen to approve recommendation of this project without concern for the citizens of this community. The environmental impacts of this project should be considered before this project moves forward. First of all, the pollution generated from the amount of trucks that are estimated to be traveling through the area will have adverse effects on the health of the residents and will deteriorate the air quality in the area. This increase in truck traffic will also affect the gridlock on the 60 freeway and surrounding streets. This is already a problem as there is only one way into the city and one way out, it will only be compounded by the addition of hundreds of more trucks. Also, these trucks bring additional noise that will affect the residents. This is all in contradiction to the general land use that was originally designated for this area. Agriculture and wildlife in the area will also be adversely affected as will the open spaces and aesthetics of the community.
