To Whom it May Concern,

Please make the following part of public record. The Residents Association of Greater Lake Mathews wishes to express its concern with regards to the Mid-County Parkway. Below are a list of issues that must be addressed.

On and off ramps from the MCP to the 215 freeway are a must. Pushing freeway loads of traffic onto a PARKWAY is simply unacceptable. The flow of traffic must be pushed onto the existing freeways and not into a sensitive habitat area.

We urge you to consider a rubberized road as the noise levels can be drastically reduced with such materials used. Noise is not only a concern for residents and businesses in the area but it can be detrimental to the surrounding habitat as well.

Jake-brakes must be limited to certain hours of the day as well as locations on where they may be used. This can be P-35-3 done as it is already in play on the CA 74 as well as some parts of Van Buren Blvd.

We all would like to see lighting placed at a minimum, and use of low pressure sodium lighting, with 90% of the light P-35-4 shielded down, to conform to Riverside County Ordinance No. 655. Lighting MUST comply with existing ordinances.

All construction must follow all MSHCP guidelines and must include ample crossings (non-traveled) under the road for all habitat areas.

Rain water runoff needs to be mitigated properly so not to create any additional flood control issues and not to P-35-6 contaminate our ground water. Construction should also be consistent with the Rainwater Capture Act of 2012 AB1750.
