Property values will plummet. There is an existing parkway that would not destroy neighborhoods and the quality of life. It is the Ramona Expressway. With only minor improvements, it would serve the purpose of the transportation corridor and not disrupt existing neighborhoods.

It has been a high-speed corridor for many years and making it into a parkway would not change the character of the surrounding community.

If there is a need for more people, vehicular traffic, noise and pollution streaming into San Jacinto and Hemet, this need can be easily met by improving the Ramona Expressway.

The rural nature of the Perris community with Perris Lake and its surrounding hills, meadows, and open areas is also a migration path for migratory water foul, bald eagles, Perigrine, red-tailed hawks kestrels, turkey vultures, and important song birds.

We strongly oppose bringing the parkway along Placentia Avenue for Perris. Money, time disruption, of neighborhoods and the rural nature of this area would be much better served by using the existing Ramona Expressway.

Costs would be reduced by using the Ramona expressway. And all the natural attributes of Perris
