It should be noted that the proposed MCP improvements will not change the hydrology of the San Jacinto River below the Ramona Expressway. Previous efforts to construct a levee at the Ramona Expressway were unsuccessful due to perceived alterations to the floodplain hydrology and its potential impacts to natural plant communities. The DEIR should acknowledge the fact that the proposed project does nothing to improve existing flooding of Interstate 215 at the San Jacinto River. The CETAP and RCIP are a failure if the County and RCTC are unable to secure a safe interstate highway/freeway system in the Mid-County area. Emergency vehicles, residents and travelers along I-215 will be unable to reach their destination during major flooding events as a result of the favored choice of flood plain preservation over public safety.
