I am opposed to the mcp and believe the only logical alternative is the "no-build" alternative.

Many unmitigable negative impacts were identified in the DEIR and their cumulative negative impacts on the surrounding communities constitute sound reasons not to build. Impacts such as increased particulate air pollution are known to cause public health problems, as reported in Riverside County's Department of Public Health's 2013 Community Health Profile. The bases of the DEIR are proposed changes to the County's and surrounding cities' General plans, future land-use designations and land acquisitions. This is a false premise since one or more of the proposed changes may never occur, leaving gaping holes in the project. Increasing truck traffic and pollution perpetuates the myth that low-paying logistics jobs are the answer to the recession and in reality only perpetuate the "bedroom community" commuter quality of life. Riverside County needs to set its sights on high-paying jobs that will improve our quality of life and preserve our natural resources and health.
